

Group Fundraising

KidKonsignNW has two great Fundraising options for you to earn money for your group: school, pre-school, team, mom's group or other organized group.

Group Fundraising Option 1-

Your group receives donations from your members/parents to sell at the sale. Your group will earn 65% of all the items sold! Sign up three workers to fill one work shift each and you'll earn an extra 10% of sales! Check out the [Volunteer Page](#) of the website for work shift opportunities.

Here is how it works:

1. Sign up your 'group' as a consignor, for example 'Sunshine Pre-school' Group. You will be assigned a consignor number which will be used for all participants of your group. Your group can register on the consignor page of the website.
2. Advertise the sale and fundraising opportunity to your members/parents. We can provide marketing materials for distribution, or you can create your own. It is in the best interest of the group/school to try to get as many people involved as possible as both shoppers and consignors.
3. **There are two easy ways to organize your items for your fundraiser:**
 1. ***Have your individual participants enter, tag and organize their donated items on their own under the group consignor number and password.***
 1. They can do this in the comfort of their own home with computer/internet access and our handy computerized system.
 2. Set a date several days before the sale and have everyone bring their items to the group organizer at a designated location.
 2. ***Your group organizer and/or several volunteers will enter, tag and organize all of the donated items under the group consignor number and password.***
 1. Individuals will bring all of their donated items to a designated location prior to the sale. This should be done as early as possible to allow adequate time to get the items organized and entered in the computer system.
4. After all the items are entered, tagged and organized, the group organizer will schedule a "drop off" appointment to drop off all of the items at the sale. This can be done in the consignor section of the website.

Group Fundraising Option 2-

Get as many members/parents that you can to sign up as an individual consignor for the sale. Your group will then receive 10% of the total sales of each consignor and the consignor will receive 55% of the total sales. If a consignor signs up for three work shifts the group and the consignor will both earn an extra 5% of the sales! Check out the volunteer section of the website for details on work shift availability!

Here is how it works:

1. We will provide marketing materials for distribution. The group/school will advertise the sale and pass out fliers to their members/parents. It is in the best interest of the group/school to try to get as many people involved as possible as both shoppers and consignors.
2. Each participant will sign up as an individual consignor with the sale. They will be assigned a consignor number which they will use to enter, tag and organize their items.
3. Each participant will need to add in your school/group name when they register. They can register on the consignor page of the website.
4. Each consignor will schedule a drop off appointment and they will drop off their items to the sale.

We know of some PTA's and teams that have earned \$500-\$1000 by participating in consignment sales and hope you will find success for your organization by joining our sale!

Additional information- This applies to both fundraising options:

- There is a minimum 10 consignors or 500 items consigned to be eligible for the program.
- Participants of your group are welcome to shop our Consignor Pre-Sale, just have your group organizer submit the names of all participants at drop off.
- Don't have time or manpower to organize and enter everything? We have another option where your organization earns less, but doesn't have to do much work! Contact us for more details.
- Promotional materials are available and include fliers to post at your school or organization, as well as postcards which can go home with students/players. Contact us to arrange a time for materials to be dropped off. Additionally, you are welcome to design your own promotional materials if you like; just send us a copy for approval prior to distribution. We can also provide you an ad or story copy to include in your bulletin or website.
